### 01 GOD'S HEART

### 02 PURPOSE OF PROPHECY

"On the other hand, those who prophesy speak to other people for their upbuilding and encouragement and consolation." (1 Cor 14:3)

### 03 FEEDBACK

▶ Be prepared to give feedback to the team on what words connected with you. This will help them to grow in their faith for prophetic ministry.

### 04 DOCUMENTATION

▶ Consider using an audio recorder or take notes right after receiving your word to ensure clarity of the word for later discernment.

## AFTER RECEIVING PROPHETIC MINISTRY

### 01 TEST THE WORDS

Ask Holy Spirit to reveal to you which parts of the words were from Him and which were not from Him.



"Do not despise prophetic words but test everything and retain what is good."  
(1 Thes 5:20-21)

### 02 ASK FOR CLARITY

Ask Holy Spirit if there is anything else He wants to speak to you from these words.



"For we know only in part, and we prophesy only in part."  
(1 Cor 13:9)

### 03 CLAIM & RECORD

Identify the words that God wants to encourage you with in this season. Honor the word by writing it down in your prayer journal.



"Fight the fight of faith according to the prophetic words spoken over you."  
(1 Tim 1:18)
